



FÉILTE 2020 Selection Criteria

- FÉILTE 2020 will take place in Dublin on 2 & 3 October.

Please note the following when completing your application:

The full FÉILTE programme will take place on Saturday, 3 October in The Helix, DCU, Dublin.

FÉILTE Fringe will take place on the evening of Friday, 2 October in The Church on Mary St/Jervis St.

The showcaser's hall will open to the public on Saturday, 3 October ONLY.

- By applying to showcase at FÉILTE 2020 you are expected to have your stand ready for opening on Saturday morning at 9.00am and to maintain it until the event closes on Saturday afternoon at 4pm. This can be facilitated by taking turns with colleagues to ensure your showcase is staffed throughout the event.
- A selection committee will review the proposals received by the closing date and will aim to ensure there is a fair geographical and sectoral balance in the selection of projects for FÉILTE. Please note that not all proposals submitted will be successful.

The closing date for submissions is Thursday, 26 March 2020.

✓ Showcases

1. Showcases must be **teacher-led** and involve collaboration between two or more teachers. They can include other partners / stakeholders.
2. We are interested in showcases that illustrate partnership between teachers and students, parents, other schools, student teachers / community leaders / local businesses / others.
3. We strive to have a balanced mix of showcasers from all sectors – primary, post-primary and further education, demonstrating how learning spans all ages.
4. Bearing in mind that members of the public will be invited to attend the event, FÉILTE projects should clearly promote to all attendees the great things that are happening in teaching, day in, day out, and how central good teaching is to all that we do.

✓ Showcaser's Stories

1. If you want to share your work with a wider audience, apply to present on the Showcaser's Stories stage!
2. This is a 7-minute slot that allows you to elaborate on your showcase stand. Talk about your journey and share the details behind what brought you here.

3. Teachers all over Ireland work extremely hard to ensure top-quality learning experiences for their students. We want to hear *your* story about the practices you engage in, the ideas you have tried and the things you would recommend to other teachers. This is your chance to showcase the work you do every day in your school.

✓ Workshops

1. There will be a number of 30-40 minute workshops at FÉILTE.
2. Workshops should be teacher-led.
3. Workshops should be interactive, and participants should be engaged in active learning. We welcome submissions from all subject areas and sectors.
4. FÉILTE workshops are not commercially based (participants should not be required to purchase materials in order to take part in the workshop).
5. You may be required to run your workshop up to three times on Saturday to facilitate the audience.

✓ TeachMeet

- TeachMeet is an informal session, where teachers share leading practice for teaching, learning and assessment with peers.
- Participants volunteer to demonstrate good practice they've delivered over the past year, or discuss an item that enhances classroom practice for **approximately 5 -7 minutes**.
- You are required to email your Powerpoint presentation to the FÉILTE team by the requested date before FÉILTE
