Hebrew Studies

In order to meet the registration requirements set down in the Teaching Council [Registration] Regulations in respect of the curricular subject of Hebrew Studies, **all** of the following criteria must be met:

- 1**
 - (a) Hebrew Studies must be studied in the degree up to and including third-year level or higher (or modular equivalent).
 - (b) The degree must be equivalent to at least Level 8 on the National Framework of Qualifications (NFQ) and with a minimum pass result in all examinations pertinent to the subject of Hebrew Studies.
 - (c) The qualifying degree must carry at least 180 ECTS (European Credit Transfer System) credits (or equivalent) with the specific study of Hebrew Studies comprising at least 60 ECTS credits (or equivalent)

- 2** The study of Hebrew Studies during the degree must show that the holder has acquired sufficient knowledge, skills and understanding to teach the Hebrew Studies syllabus to the highest level in post-primary education (see www.curriculumonline.ie).

- a) Classical Hebrew Language
- b) History of the Hebrew People
- c) Hebrew Bible
- d) The Mishnah
