## General Biography

Martin Brown, is Associate Professor, Head of School of Policy and Practice, Co-Director, the Centre for Evaluation, Quality and Inspection (EQI) DCU Institute of Education and elected member of the Centre for Culturally Responsive Evaluation and Assessment at the University of Illinois at Urbana Champaign is a specialist in educational evaluation and assessment and has planned and led evaluations in Ireland, Northern Ireland, Europe and the Middle East; working for, among others, the Dept. of Education and Skills (Ireland), the European Commission.

He is Co-Director at the Centre for Evaluation, Quality and Inspection (EQI), an external advisor to the Teaching Council of Ireland.

He has received two all Island SCOTENS Awards (2018/2020) for outstanding research in Teacher Education and has received the President of DCU Gold medals for Research Impact and Teaching and Learning (2020). In 2021 he also received the President of DCU Gold medal for Civic Engagement for his work with School Communities in Northern Ireland

Martin has a B.Sc and H.Ed from NUI Maynooth and an M.Sc and PhD from Dublin City University.
