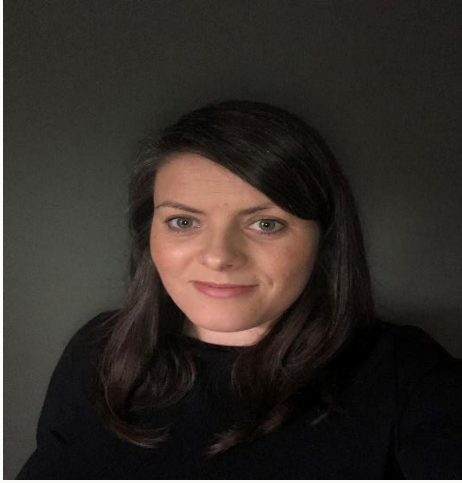


Tomás Ó Ruairc is Director of the Teaching Council since 2012 and will be chairing this webinar.
